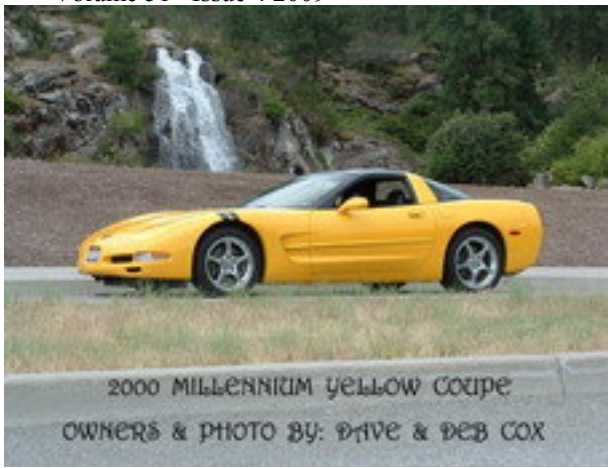

33,682 Corvettes were built in 2000, 18,113 of those were coupes. A total of 3,578 Corvettes had the 79 Millennium Yellow color code (first year it was available) and the base Corvette coupe sold for \$39,475 plus an additional charge of \$500 for the Millennium Yellow exterior color. This additional charge was not for the color but due to the special process and equipment required for a tinted clear coat which added visual depth to the paint's appearance. A 350ci, 345 hp engine, Delco stereo cassette , and leather seats were included with all models.

**The meeting was adjourned at 8:25 PM**

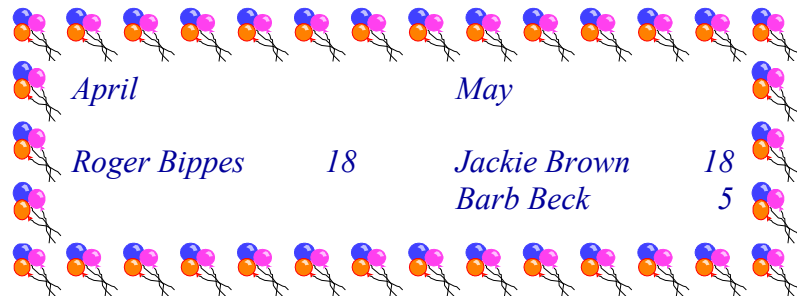

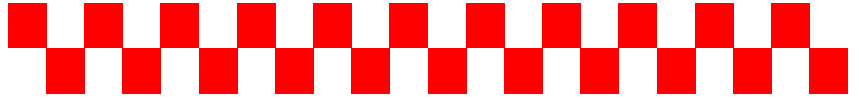
