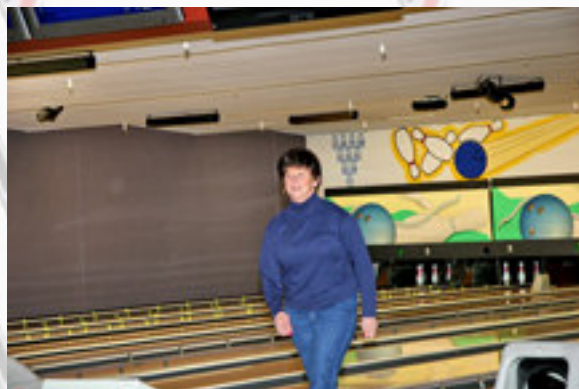

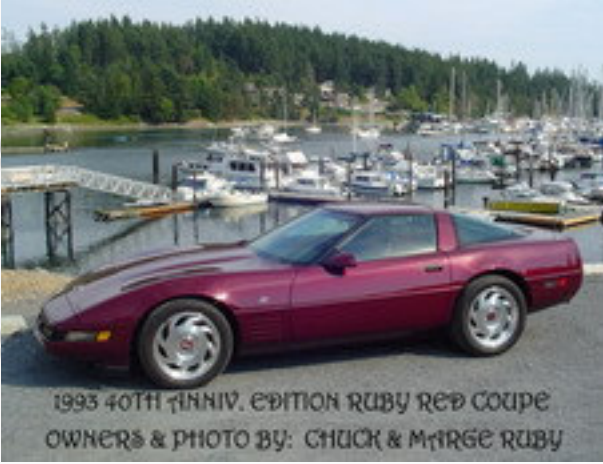

### Chronology

The 1960 Corvette was the first with an aluminum radiator (limited to high-lift camshaft engines), the last to have taillights formed into the rounded rear fenders, and the first to exclude the combination of automatic transmission and fuel-injected engine. A Corvette in the Briggs Cunningham team finished eighth overall in the GT class at the 24-hours of Le Mans. Production of 10,261 was the first to reach five figures. Ferrari competed well in SCCA Class B-production but finished second to Bob Johnson and his Corvette
