I purchased my 2004 Z06 in August of 2007 from Jeff Rogers. He bought it new from Jim at Camp Chevrolet. I had always wanted a Z06 ever since I got to take a test drive at Dave Smith's Auto in 2003 when I purchased a new truck. One Saturday morning when my wife and I were taking a walk I casually mentioned to her that I saw an interesting add in the classified section of the paper for a Z06 Corvette. It had only 6200 miles and was asking blue book pricing. She knew that I had always wanted a Z06 and said "why don't you go look at it?" "You are not getting any younger" So I called my brother in law who had a 2007 coupe and we went to check it out. I had within 2 months previously had a hip replaced and needed someone else to test drive it for me. When we pulled up, Jeff had his 4 car garage open—the Z06 looked like new. I later found out that Jeff owned Jeff's Custom Auto Detail



and whenever he would take the Z06 for a spin, he would bring it back into his garage and clean the brake dust off the wheels and detail the car. It had only been washed once in 2 years! I kept telling my brother in law to shut up because he kept mentioning that the car was like new and I wanted to talk Jeff a little down on his asking price of \$39000.

I didn't have to take it for a test drive and knew that I wanted it when I first saw it. I asked if he would take \$1000 off his price and he agreed. That was on a Saturday, and it was in my garage the following Friday after my loan was approved. It now has 7000 miles on it and was only washed once more after the barbeque at "Glass on Grass" last year. The first 8 months after I purchased the Z06, my wife's Z71 Silverado had to sit outside during the winter so my Vette was safe and warm.

The next spring we had an extension put on our garage so now all of our vehicles will fit. I still owe her big time for not only making her keep her truck outside for winter months, but also for letting me get my dream car. Thank you sweetheart! I have since added a throttle body, K & N intake, lower 185 degree thermostat. and a kick ass B & B Bullitt Exhaust. I took it out to Shelley Performance on the dyno and had it all dialed in. Just by doing these little extras, it when from 405 to 460 horsepower.
