RPO Z51's larger brakes were added to F55 Adjustable Suspension. New options included two-tone seats for coupes and convertibles, and a non-recommended colors over-ride. Steering wheel radio controls were included with uplevel Bose systems. There were two special editions: The Ron Fellows Z06 honored the famed racer. Painted Artic White, it was the first signed limited edition (399) in Corvette history. Corvette paced the Indy 500 on May 27, 2007. 500 Atomic Orange convertible replicas were sold. Total production of 40,561 was the highest since 1984.
