2007 Facts

Daytona Sunset Orange Metallic exterior paint was replaced by Atomic Orange Metallic. Unlike the color it replaced, Atomic Orange was extra cost due to an additional tint coat. This brought Corvette's extra cost color palette to four; LeMans Blue (\$300), and Velocity Yellow, Monterey Red and Atomic Orange at \$750 each.

Previously, Chevrolet recommended combinations of exterior, interior and convertible top colors. Dealers could often override the recommended combinations, but not in 2006 or 2006. For 2007, overrides were permitted with an extra cost option, RPO D30 at \$590.
